

## **Weed Control and Wildlife Habitat Management Program Landowner Technical Assistance Application Information**

Endless Mountains RC&D Council and its partners are offering technical assistance to landowners for the purpose of identifying weed control and wildlife habitat issues. We are offering visits by one of our contractors to walk your property with you to assess the weed control issues you might have and to help identify troublesome weeds particularly any noxious or invasive weeds. In addition the contractor will help you identify beneficial plants for wildlife and habitat features that are good as well as those that could be improved.

**Any interested landowner must submit an application to Endless Mountains RC&D Council by May 25, 2010.** Applications must be filled out in its entirety and signed by the landowner for consideration. Field visits require the landowner to be present during the visit. If the person responsible for management of the land is different from the landowner, then both individuals will need to be present. **Visits must occur between June 1 and August 13, 2010.** The visits are FREE, completely voluntary, for educational purposes only and performed by request of the landowner. The contractor working in your area will contact you after June 1<sup>st</sup> to set up an appointment for the visit.

We do request that each landowner fill out a *Landowner Technical Assistance Evaluation Form* immediately after the field visit and send it back to Endless Mountains RC&D Council within one week, so we can evaluate the service to make improvements.
